Head Coach

Curt Wiese

In his first year as the head coach at UMD Coach Wiese led the Bulldogs to an 11-2 record, an NSIC Northern Division Title, and a sixth straight NCAA Division II playoff appearance.

Since Wiese's arrival at UMD in February 2008 as the Offensive Coordinator, the Bulldogs have gone 73-9 (a record unmatched by any NCAA II school), captured two NCAA II national championships (2008 and 2010), four Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference titles and Six NSIC North Division crowns, made five NCAA II playoff appearances and produced two perfect 15-0 seasons.
